



Chris Solomon Takes All Stars Series Victory

Gisborne's Chris Solomon has taken out a thrilling 2016/2017 Mainline Dynolog Dynamometers All Stars Series after a thrilling conclusion last night at Mildura's Timmis Speedway. Solomon also created history by emulating his brother Paul's 2008/2009 Championship and become the first brothers to win the Series. Chris gained 5011 points. It is also car owner Tony Bartlett's third Championship as a car owner.

Defending Champion Brenten Farrer did everything he could to protect his series lead before a late race incident ended his night. Farrer finished on 5010 points just a solitary point behind Solomon. Daniel Evans capped off a good season by taking a well-deserved third place finish over all. In what was a consistent season which saw him pick up a maiden SA 360 Title Win, Multiple All Stars Podiums and a Round Victory at Waikerie. Evans gathered enough points to sneak into the Top 3 finishing on 4951. Phil Lock capped off another solid year which saw him finish in 4th place overall. The V4 finished on 4950, just one point behind Evans in third. Paul Solomon who was leading the series early on and also won the John Sidney Racing King of the River rounded out the top 5 on 4886. Cody Atkins was next in line in 6th with 4755 points. He was followed by Kane Newcombe on 4646 points in 7th, Jarman Dalitz on 4643 points in 8th, Jack Gartner on 4585 points in 9th with Daniel Ellis on 4325 points rounding out the top 10.

Drivers and Crews, Officials and Sponsors will now enjoy the Series Presentation tonight at Fossey's Gin Emporium in Mildura where many awards will be handed out as well as more inductions into the All Stars Hall of Fame.
