

# #V7 PAUL SOLOMON Decisive Win at Heartland Allstars



**Paul Solomon** in the A Plus Powder Coating #7 XXX Chassis was the standout car and driver at round 3 of the Sprintcar Allstar Series for 2016/7.

Paul won the time trial and his heat race (from the front row) and then in the second round of heats, he finished in 4th place after starting down the back.



He was the top point scorer which enabled him to start out of P1 for the A main and lead every lap of the race.

A mid race incident with a lapped car running up over the back of the #7 could have put him out of the race, but luck was on Paul's side and went on to win.
